



Farm Safety Art Contest

hosted by the New York Center for Agricultural Medicine and Health

Theme: "One Seat, One Rider"

Prompt: Create a one-page design about keeping people safe by not allowing extra riders on tractors, ATVs, or other equipment that was not designed to transport more than one operator. Designs can be print or digital.

How to participate: This contest is open to K-12 graders in New York State. Contest opens September 16, 2024. Deadline to submit projects is November 15, 2024. Follow criteria and instructions below to submit your artwork:

Winners will be announced in December 2024. First and second place monetary awards will be given in three groups: K-4th grade, 5th-8th grade, 9th-12th grade. Each group will have separate awards for print designs and digital designs. Designs are graded based on the following categories:

Content/Safety Message: The design is relevant to the chosen topic and shares accurate information about staying safe in an agricultural or rural environment
Design/Creativity: The design is creative. The design makes good use of space with few blank spots. Images or drawings are clear. Overall neatness.
Text: Any text is displayed in easy to read colors, fonts/handwriting, and size. Placement of text makes sense and does not make it more difficult to read.
