ROPS are 99% effective in preventing injury or death in the event of an overturn when used with a seatbelt; they are 70% effective when used without a seatbelt. 

Farm Safety Walkthroughs*

Sometimes called an on-farm safety survey, these are conducted with an owner or manager. Our agricultural safety specialist walks with you through your farm and combines farm hazard identification with discussion to help you understand what might be hazardous, why and how to reduce the risk of injury. A detailed, confidential report is provided to your farm.

Occupational Health Clinic

Our occupational health doctor and clinic staff provide health exams for the prevention, diagnosis and treatment of health issues related to farm work. Hearing tests and DOT physicals are also available.
